

COVID-19 Risk Assessment as of 13th July 2020 for Manor Barn B&B, Child Okeford, Dorset, DT11 8EF

What are the hazards?

Person to person contact between host and guest.

Who might be harmed and how?

Becoming infected with COVID-19 and further spread the infection

What we are doing to control the risk.

- Minimising contact between the two parties.
- Only taking reservations from one household for either one or both rooms.
- Ensuring guests are not present during room cleans.
- Guests staying for 3 nights or less will not have their room cleaned to avoid risk of transmission. Extra toilet rolls will be supplied in the room.
- Using only single packaged items for tea, coffee, cereals etc.
- General precautions are 1 metre social distancing, regular hand washing, hand sanitiser available on entering and leaving the building.
- All breakfast items will be cleaned thoroughly and cutlery and crockery placed in the dishwasher at the highest temperature.
- The dining room window will be opened after guests have left, tables, chairs and high-touch areas will be cleaned and disinfected.
- When guests leave, all bedding and towels will be washed at the highest temperature using a laundry disinfectant or sent to a commercial laundry.
